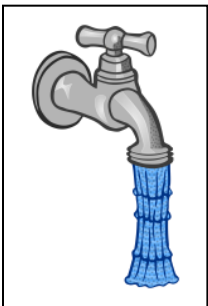
Campers will learn about big machines, equipment, tools, and safety while building special projects. ***EACH WEEK WILL BE DIFFERENT**
