**Did you know?** For patients diagnosed with leukemia, lymphoma, and other life-threatening diseases, a bone marrow or cord blood transplant may be their best or only hope for a cure. Yet 70% of patients who need a transplant do not have a fully matched donor in their family. They depend on *Be The Match* to find a donor to save their life. The Outreach Committee will be providing more information on *Be The Match* at church next Sunday, April 2. Individuals who are between the ages of 18 to 40 will be eligible to join the match registry through a quick two-minute process.

Automated external defibrillators (AEDs) have been installed in all of our church buildings. They can be found in the following locations: in the Education Building above the water fountain, in the Hyder House near the water fountain, in the Welcome Center on the back wall, and in the hallway of the Mattie Bell Building. AEDs are used to assist someone experiencing cardiac arrest. Please note their locations in the event of a medical emergency.
